To add Latin style effects to this piece, try a 1-3-5 arpeggio in the bass; double the tonic note in octaves if possible. In the treble, use a "cookie cutter" shape to play the melody notes with your thumb and the note a sixth below with your ring finger. And if you like, try the glissando suggested in measure 16 leading into the chorus.
