
## Jupiter (Theme)



Gustav Holst wrote his seven-movement work "The Planets" between 1914 and 1917. The piece quickly became popular and is often performed and recorded. Movement 4, "Jupiter, the Bringer of Jollity", contains a slow middle theme which embodies nobility and generosity, and which became well-known on its own. In 1921, Holst adapted it as a hymn tune, and called it "Thaxted" after the village in which he lived.
